Connecting Elderly@Carehomes During Covid 19 lockdown

In May 2020, when the coronavirus cases peaked in the UK, the social distancing and temporary separation from families had a far reaching impact on our elderly societies especially those staying at care homes. TRF realised that elderly residents in the care homes were struggling to connect with their loved ones due to limited communication channels, hence, it was decided to launch the 'Connecting Elderly@Carehomes with Families' campaign and we donated more than 70 Electronic Tablets devices to the Care Homes around London.

The residents at care homes were overwhelmed with the gesture as while in isolation, residents could now browse channels, read or even play games and showcase their artistic side! Most importantly they were able to communicate with their loved ones via the video calls.



In June 2020, we were contacted by several other care homes to find out if they could be donated a tablet as well, due to the overwhelming response the campaign continued. We further decided to distribute electronic hand held devices to various care homes and nursing homes around London.

TRF Charity initiative during Covid-19

“Stay home. Protect the NHS. Save lives.” The UK Government’s message has been clear: we all could do our bit during the Covid-19 crisis by just staying indoors. However, in response to Covid-19, many have decided to do more by volunteering time and energy to help their communities. TRF also decided to support as many people as we could.

In April 2020, when the prime minister was struggling to breathe, the Queen on TV compared the crisis to the second world war and the death toll was not far from double the usual rate and we knew it was the peak of a devastating 22 days in April in which more than 1,000 people in the UK died from Covid-19 every day. TRF decided to do its ‘bit’ to appreciate, motivate and respect the NHS and the unsung Heroes. TRF has shown its gratitude to both. TRF worked with the Hillingdon Hospital’s food bank team and helped them setting up the food bank for the key workers by donating the dry supplies.

TRF also acknowledged the unsung warriors in the front line of our daily lives eg. the stars at the various shops providing us the essentials. We served a thank you lunch to one such team at Sainsbury’s Stanmore branch. It was an expression of gratitude for serving our community in these challenging times by making sure we had food on our tables .



TRF Charity School Update

In previous years TRF supported multiple initiatives and charities like NavjotiManovikas Kendra, (NMK), Jodhpur&Sona Manovikas Kendra (SMK), Bhilwara.

Since these schools support special and mentally challenged children who are in the highly vulnerable group due to Covid-19 pandemic they had to close the school during lockdown.

However, their teachers have been doing excellent work during the closure. Following are some of the details.

- They have been in regular contact with Parents of Children enquiring of their well-being and giving advices.
- Guiding parents and children regarding educational tasks to be done at home and engaging in vocational trainings. Guiding for behavioural problems they may have with children.
- NMK's sports teacher Mr Mahesh has been doing excellent work with virtual sports competitions organised by Special Olympics Bharat. The children have won 25 Gold and Silver medals in virtual sports during the closure of school in basketball dribbling, dancing, singing, table tennis, cricket, Bocce etc. He was also rewarded by the State Government for the work.
- NMK is also distributing food packets to the needy in these difficult times and giving 15 days ration to the daily wage earners whose children are studying in NMK. They have distributed 300 food packets daily to the needy for 52 days.

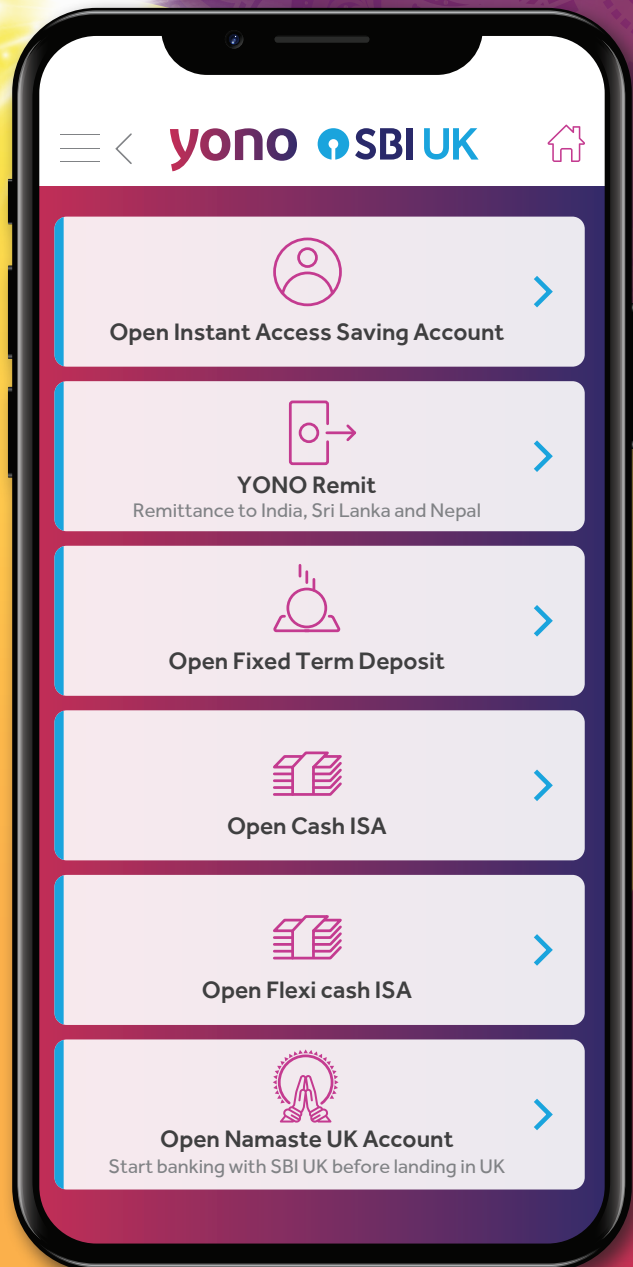

- TRF organised a successful Youth trip to Jodhpur and Jaipur in 2016 for our Youths to learn more about the culture and history of Rajasthan.

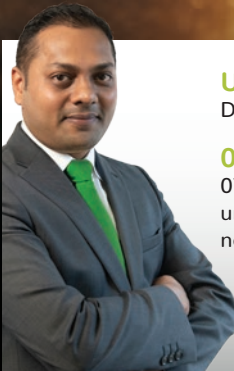
Charity:

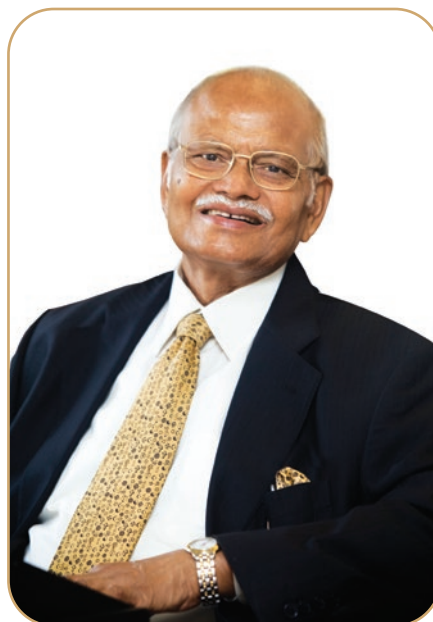
A Message

With the kind donations and support from everyone, we managed to send a sizeable amount of clothes to India, and it was heartwarming to see the childrens' reactions.

We organised the clothes by age and then folded and packed them: ready to be sent off to India. The clothes of this year are on their way, but here is a picture of last year's collection of clothes being worn by children.

This project is a very humbling and reflective experience, because it really made us feel very grateful for what we have, and our power to help those who need it. The children get warm, protective clothing for the year of good quality and make, and we always feel warm when we see the joy the clothes bring. The reusing of clothes also is an amazing way of reducing our waste, and carbon footprint, and generally helping our world and its environment without having to do very much at all.

We are always open and willing to take in new donations of good condition and quality, ages ranging anywhere from two to sixteen years of age. Feed The Workers

No one has fathomed or had foreseen the seriousness of the pandemic and the challenges one would face. In what seems like a lifetime ago and in far more uncertain times we all do remember seeing or reading about a very heartbreaking video of a NHS nurse crying because she couldn't buy food from an empty superstore after a long shift at work. It was truly soul stirring given that the rest of us were mostly busy spending hours on Netflix or the internet. It was time to put myself to better use and help the frontline workers in NHS in some way.

I started a charitable initiative, "Feed The Workers" along with some friends, the idea was to distribute free meals to doctors, nurses and staff of various hospitals who were inundated with patients in critical condition and were risking it all just to make sure the rest of us were safe. The meals were just an expression of gratitude and the least we could do to show our appreciation and gratefulness to them. Feed The Workers partnered with local restaurants, caterers and drivers in the community to deliver hot meals to many hospitals. It was designed to serve the triple objective of expressing our gratitude to the NHS heroes as well as help local community of restaurants and delivery business.

After a hectic few phone calls, discussions and coordinations our first meal was delivered to Northwick Park hospital within just 2 days of starting the initiative. Seeing the reaction and overwhelming response from the doctors, nurses and support staff spurred us on and we quickly expanded our reach to many more hospitals across London. We managed to raise over £25,000 and delivered more than 3000 meals across 11 hospitals. We partnered with Millies Cookies during our campaign. We are humbled to be featured on BBC online news.

Many of our donors came from this very community (TRF) and I would like to personally (virtually only at the moment) thank each and everyone of you who donated so kindly to our cause. This would not have been possible without the rest of the team many of who recently graduated to become junior doctors. They are Dr Suraj Joshi, Dr. Jagruti Gohil, Dr Harris Rahim, Dr Abi Chandrashekar, Dr Aneesh Aggarwal and Tilak Joshi who have sourced contacts in hospitals, and coordinated countless deliveries. We thank you once again for your generosity.
